Mandatory Documents

Tatty Bumpkin Yoga Teachers must have:

- An Enhanced on-line DBS check
- Full insurance for teaching (this can be obtained through Yoga Alliance professionals)
- Attended paediatric first aid course and safeguarding courses.
- Completed the Children Inspired by Yoga Teacher application form

Practice Experience

Students should have at least 40 hours of adult Yoga practice experience, so they have a strong knowledge of Yoga practice. These practice hours can be completed before, during or after completing the full Children Inspired by Yoga Teacher Training.

Course Provisions

- A 15.25 hour Tatty Bumpkin training and assessment by qualified Yoga Alliance Professionals SYT.
- A 16.75 hour Baby Bumpkin training and assessment by qualified Yoga Alliance Professionals SYT.

Cancellations

- **Code of Conduct during the courses.** Tatty Bumpkin Ltd aims to lead a fully interactive course and welcomes comments, and insights from all students throughout the course. Students are expected to:
 - Be punctual for the start times of the course
 - Be able to fully attend to the course.
 - Be respectful to the thoughts, ideas and needs of everyone on the course.
- **Minimum attendance rate.** Students must attend 100% of the course. If this is not possible due to unforeseen circumstances students will be asked to either
 - Attend the sections of the trainings they missed on a subsequent training.
 - Stay after the course times, or arrive early to cover the sections missed with the course tutor
- **Re-sitting of assignments.** Pass standards are set and moderated by Tatty Bumpkin Ltd. If any student does achieve the required pass standard, they may be asked to:
 - Attend another training course. This will incur a further charge.
 - To redo their written assignments – there will be a further charge for each assignment.
- **Extensions.** For the written assignments, an extension will be granted if the student is unable to complete the requirements due to unforeseen circumstance. The extension period will be at the discretion of Tatty Bumpkin Ltd.
